It would also be helpful for services to start thinking now about who may not have capacity to make this decision and identifying those people who may need best interest decisions making about this. A number of people with learning disabilities across the district have refused the flu vaccine previously and we would want to encourage early conversations with these people in particular so they are aware of the risks involved of not having the vaccine.
